# MISSION 25

In the summer of 1944, it was statistically impossible for the pilots of the 8th Airforce to complete 25 missions over the battlefields of Germany. Too many men lost their lives. For Colonel Stanley Hand, little did he know, that his 25th mission would be on D-Day...and because of a new technology called Radar, he would save thousands of American lives.

The men of the Mighty Eighth would not seize a single island nor would they liberate as much as one country. They would have no parades through the Arc de Triumph, nor would there be as much as a single battle named after the ground they took. Their success would be measured by the number of German fighters destroyed, by the number of German airfields rendered unusable, and by the number of German aircraft factories bombed to rubble. Their war was measured by the number of Luftwaffe aircraft that showed up on D-Day and history would record that number as... 2. They'd done their job.
